




GARDEN GROVE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT Newhope Elementary Dress Code



Vision: We are committed to preparing all students to be successful and responsible citizens who contribute and thrive in a diverse society.

Mission: To ensure student success, we will provide a rigorous and supportive academic experience that motivates all learners to meet high expectations.

Our GGUSD Board of Education and school expect students to dress in a manner appropriate to learning and educational advancement. Students should wear attire designed for comfort and safety that accommodates optimal participation in school related activities.

Please review our school's dress code and sign below indicating that you understand the guidelines and have reviewed the expectations with your child.

- Tops must adequately cover the entire areas of the shoulder and midriff section. No spaghetti straps or crop tops are allowed. Any shorts, skirts, or dresses should cover just slightly above the knees and be at least 2/3 thigh length.
- Shoes need to completely cover the toes and heel. Athletic shoes provide the most comfort and durability for all school events. No flip-flops, sandals or heels are allowed.
- Clothing needs to fit appropriately and should not be excessively baggy or tight. Undergarments should not be seen.
- Students are allowed to wear hats, outside of the classroom only, that offer protection from the sun. Sweatshirt hoodies are not to be worn.
- Students' skin should be free of any type of tattoos or drawings.
- Hair should be the normal range of color.
- Student clothing should be respectful and free of logos or pictures that highlight alcohol, drugs, tobacco, sexual content, violence, or degrading activities. Shirts that carry a negative message should also be avoided.
- Jewelry should be discreet and not cause unsafe conditions during physical activity. Hoops and dangling earrings are not permitted due to potential for harm when engaging in physical fitness activities.
- No cellphone watches allowed.
- Make-up and Acrylic/fake nails are not appropriate for elementary school-aged students, nor permissible. The length of nails should not pose a safety concern when playing sports or engaging in physical fitness activities during recess.

Parents will be notified of inappropriate attire in order to assist their child in following and adhering to these guidelines. We appreciate your support in ensuring our students dress comfortably, scholarly, and in a manner that promotes a positive self-image.
